1) Clerk Update

a) To note repairs to office lighting.

The lights in the IP17 Good Neighbours Scheme Office have been replaced with LED fitments after a fault was reported. The Clerk arranged the repair after consulting with Chair of the Committee.

b) To receive an update on the station planting.

The perennial plants are arriving on the 29th of April and will require planting with some soil improvement. The Town Council can have up to 6 volunteers planting the area if they are socially distanced.

c) To receive an update on war memorial restoration

Suffolk Monuments who are in Saxmundham have offered to clean and restore the War Memorial free of charge. The Clerk is suggesting that the Council offers to pay for any materials they may need.

2) Memorial Landscape Project

Councillors Eastman, Hawkins, Hedley Lewis and the Clerk met to discuss the Memorial Field Project. The working group made the following recommendations.

- a) That the development plan considers Seamans Avenue play area and Memorial Field.
- b) That a full basic survey be completed for the site Councillor Hedley Lewis offered to draft specification.
- c) That clarification on the ownership and deeds of both areas, is required. The Clerk to produce details.
- d) Key items to be included in the design -War Memorial/Covid Memorial, Outdoor Gym, Wildlife friendly planting, New Gates, Wheelchair accessible paths, addressing health safety risks including fencing for Seaman's Avenue Play Area.
- e) That Play companies be approached for ideas and quotes on the fencing and landscaping of the Seaman's Avenue Play Area.

Draft document for tenders to survey Seaman Avenue Play Area and the Memorial Playing Field TENDER TO SURVEY THE SEAMAN AVENUE PLAY AREA AND MEMORIAL FIELD SAXMUNDHAM

Saxmundham Town Council is inviting tenders for a topological survey to the above areas with a view to obtaining designs and enhancing the existing amenities. Enhancements will be subject to consultation but may include play equipment, paths, an additional entrance to the NW corner and planting.

The extent of the survey should include: the kerb-line along the Play Area frontage to Seaman Avenue; the kerb-line to Rendham Road extending 10m beyond the Memorial Field frontage; the kerb-line to Gilbert Road; boundaries to the Play Area and Memorial Field. Note: the gated field in which the water tower is located is excluded from the survey.

The survey drawing should include, but not be limited to: boundary fencing and gates; footprints of structures (buildings, access ramps and steps skate-park, and pill box); hard surfaces; features such as gullies and inspection covers; benches, goals, signs and bins; culverts and ditches; grass, hedges, trees and canopies; play equipment.

North point and scale should be indicated.

The survey should be delivered with two copies in digital format and set out for reading at 1:100 and 1:50 scales on maximum A0 size hard copy; and also with four hard copies at 1:100 and 1:50 scale.

Tenders should indicate price and timescale for delivery together with company information.

Any queries should be forwarded to the Council, and answers will be circulated to all bidders. The site has open access.

Below ground services and including drains are not required at this stage

Levels are not required at this stage but changes of level to steps, kerbs etc. should be indicated.

The tender should include a separate price for including levels and below ground services survey at a later date and within 2 years.

Risk assessments will be required prior to a start on site and the areas will remain in public use. Access and toilet provision will be through the Town Council.






Waymarker Disks - Trail Markers








Details of the Route

Indicative Costs

need to cast a concrete base with a sleeve supplied by UF

8m mast is the highest UF do in aluminum (recyclable). 8m Al. mast: £200 plus Vat

Fibreglass is the more expensive option but can go higher - 8m fibreglass mast: £450 plus Vat

An 8m mast would suit an 8' x 4' flag

8' x 4' Union flag woven and stitched and with anti-fray: £81 plus Vat
