Directions

Take Junction 29 of the M25 and follow the A127 towards Southend. Exit at Dunton (sign posted) approximately 5 minutes from the M25.

Follow signs for Laindon and Southfields Industrial Area, B148.

Follow the road until you arrive at a roundabout with a clock tower. Here you need to take the first exit.

You will approach a smaller roundabout, take the third exit onto Bramston Way, we are the first building on the right.

If you become lost, head for Toomey's Motor Village (clock tower roundabout) and call us on 01268 564664 and we shall guide you.
